

EMnet Remote Alert Program

Is your EMnet terminal located where not everyone can see it? Would you like to get notified on your newsroom computers, and studio internet computers of an incoming emergency message? If so, Comlabs has a free program called EMAlerter that can be installed on any computer that is on the same network as your EMnet terminal. The EMAlerter program will pop up with a box that shows the subject of the Emergency message. Most stations use the EMAlerter program along with the Pager Notification function of the EMnet software. The Pager notification function will Email the full emergency message to any email addresses you specify. The EMAlerter software will then alert you to check your Email or go to the EMnet terminal for the full emergency message.

To download the EMAlerter software please contact Comlabs, or go to [FTP://www.lightnerelectronics.com](ftp://www.lightnerelectronics.com). The user name is pab and the password is pab for the ftp site. Along with downloading the EMAlerterSetup.exe you will need the password.txt file (Password for installing EMAlerter).

The Software can only be installed on the same network as your EMnet terminal. You will need to enable your EMnet computer to output a multicast packet for EMAlerter to work.

To setup your EMnet terminal to use EMAlerter:

1. Right click on the green satellite dish, and select reconfigure receiver.
2. Enter your EMnet password (Normally EMnet)
3. When the EMnet Receiver Configuration screen comes up click "Remote Alerts"
4. Check the box "Enable Remote Alerting" and press OK
5. Click Next and then Finish
